

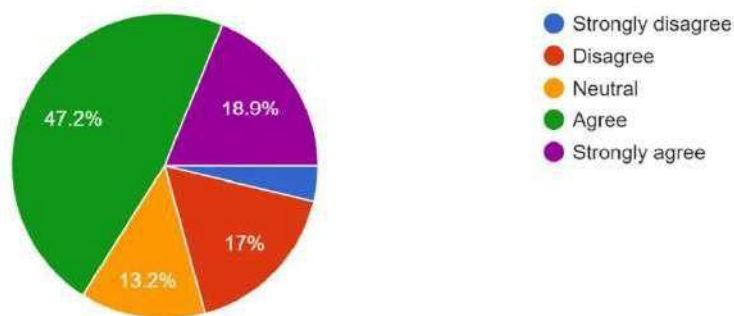

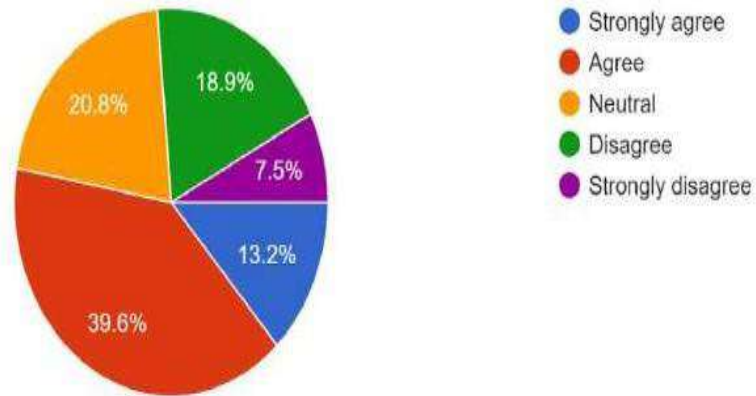
Aims & Objectives of the syllabi are well defined & clear to teachers

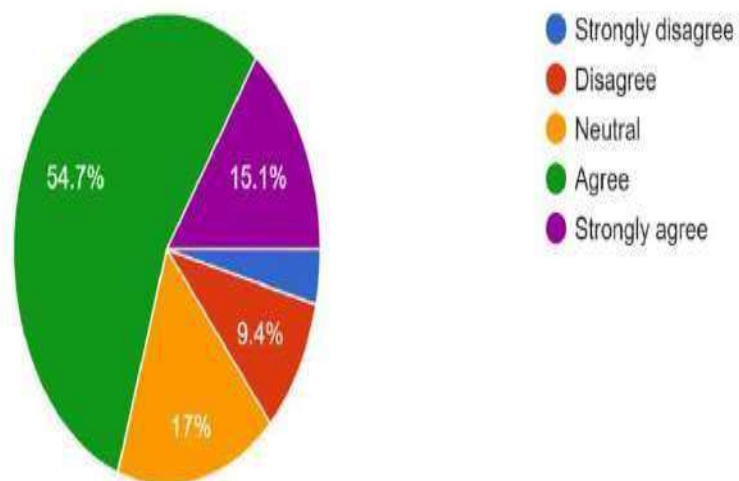
The course / syllabus has good balance between theory & application

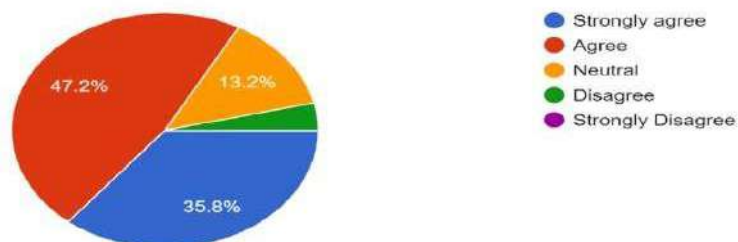
The books prescribed/listed as reference materials are relevant, updated & appropriate

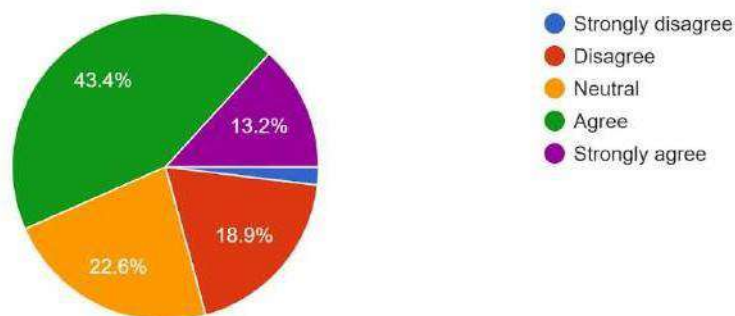
I have the freedom to adopt new techniques / strategies of teaching to make the students active like group discussions, students paper presentation ,debate etc.

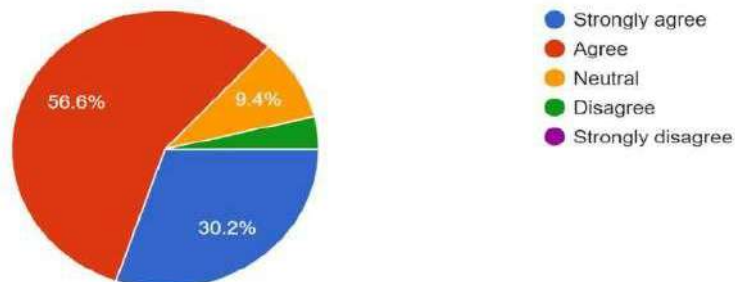

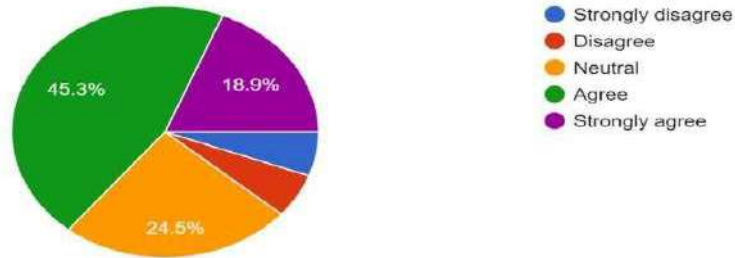
Internal assessment is transparent & robust in terms of frequency & mode

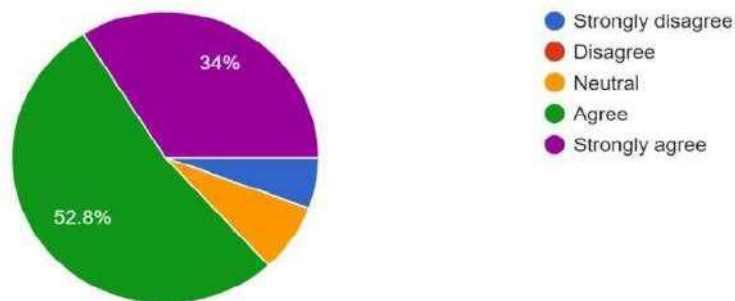

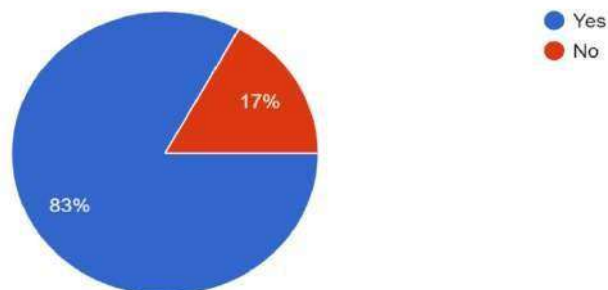

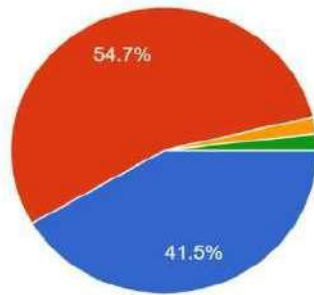
Program outcomes & Course Outcomes are evaluated by the department after publication of Final Year Students University Exams Results.
