Agenda No. 1. Confirmation of the minutes of previous meeting held on 09.07.2014

Agenda No. 2. UGC-IQAC Grant

The Chair announced that the grant of Rs.3,00,000/-(Rupees Three Lakh only)has been sanctioned to college by UGC(letter no.F.IQAC-W-092/13-14 ERO)dated 19th March 2014 towards **the scheme of Internal Quality Assurance Cells (IQAC) during XII plan period** & we will receive the grant from UGC-ERO very soon. All the members are very happy.



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Agenda No.3. Innovative Teaching –Learning process

The coordinator informed that to make the teaching —learning process more student-centric various innovative teaching methods like Power point presentation, students' seminar, Departmental quiz, Group discussion, Film shows ,Survey, Term Papers, Industrial visit, Educational tour, Special lecture are employed by the faculty members.

The Chair told that the advance learners of the class should be motivated to help other students of the class to learn & two Tutorial classes per week (one for 1st year Hons. & one for 2nd year Hons.) should be taken by each faculty member to identify high &low achievers and to guide them accordingly so that the slow learners/low achievers can reach the minimum qualifying level.

Agenda No.4. Mentoring System for Students

The Chair requested the Coordinator to introduce Mentoring System for students. She further told that student mentoring will help in overall development of the students. Faculty members should guide the students in their academic & stress related issues.

Agenda No.5. Faculty Development Programmes

The Chair informed that IQAC always motivate and encourage faculty members to join/avail FDP under UGC XII Plan & encourage to participate in Refresher/ Orientation/Short term Course.

The Chair mentioned that three of our faculty members-Prof. Anindita Banerjee from Deptt. of Philosophy, Prof.Palash Mondal from Deptt. of History & Prof. Aparna Sadhu from Deptt. of Philosophy joined UGC-FDP under XII Plan for two years to complete their Ph.D. work.
